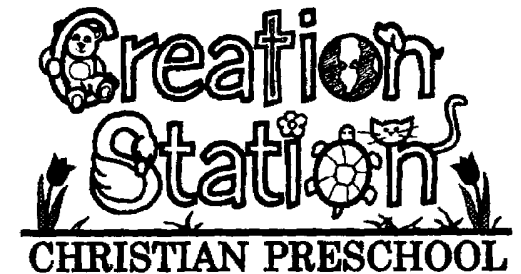

Who may attend?

The **One To Grow On** class offers
an enriched curriculum that emphasizes:
* beginning reading/writing skills
* math readiness

This pre-K class is designed for older 4 and 5
year olds.

through May.**

What is the cost of the 2010-2011 program?

Two day morning session=\$105.00
Two day afternoon session=\$85.00
Three day morning session = \$155.00
Three day afternoon session=\$125.00
One To Grow On = \$155.00
monthly
